BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING RN-BSN PROGRAM

The RN-BSN plan of study offers the flexibility of online education. This option allows registered nurses who are graduates of accredited associate degree or diploma programs to earn a BSN.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Minimally, the following criteria must be met:

- * Admission to Kentucky State University.
- * An earned diploma or associate degree in nursing from a nationally accredited nursing program .
- * Official transcripts from all schools attended.
- * Pre-requisite education courses completed and on the official transcript before beginning the nursing program at Kentucky State University.
- * Overall GPA of at least 2.8 on a 4.0 scale on associate degree or diploma coursework.
- * Verification of current unencumbered license to practice nursing in the prospective student's state of residence prior to enrollment in first program course.
- * Personal essay.
- * One academic and one professional reference.
- * Apply to the School of Nursing through NursingCAS (https://nursingcas.org/).

APPLICATION DEADLINE

All application materials must be received before the deadline established for the year the student desires to enter the BSN Program. Applicants are processed through NursingCAS (https://nursingcas.org/), the centralized application service for nursing.
