The Kentucky State University Police Department ensures the safety and security of all campus visitors. Police Officers are fully trained and sworn peace officers and are required to be certified through the Kentucky Department of Criminal Justice Training in accordance with KRS 15.380(1)(d). Through KRS 164.955, Kentucky State University police officers have general police powers, including the power of arrest.

We are a full-service agency and operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
